# PROGRAMME GOAL



- Bay Olympic will participate and compete within the 2024 Mixed NRFL Programme.
- Our Girls Only teams will compete at the highest possible 2024 NRF level - entering Girls NRFL U14 & U16 in 2025.
- To provide an environment that will develop and challenge individual youth players, encouraging them to play at the highest possible level with Bay Olympic.
- Producing youth players capable of transitioning to our U23 and Senior Premier teams; aspiring to play at the highest levels possible across the football landscape.

# SELECTION POLICY

- Players have been selected to create the best possible squads, prioritising by proximity to Senior Premier squad ie. U23, U17, U15, U14 & U13.
- Players selected outside their age group ie. if a player has the ability, attitude, and mental maturity it is our view they should aspire to challenge themselves at the highest level possible and/or older age group.
- Any movement between game day age groups throughout the year will be challenge point based with the intention of further developing the player.

## 2024 SELECTIONS

- Squads, including up to two goal keepers have been selected within each Grade - U13, U14, U15 & U17
- To further develop players within the Club, additional players will be invited to attend TDP trainings.
- All players MUST register for the 2024 Season through Bay Olympic's membership management platform, Friendly Manager.
- Accepting your place within the TDP Programme confirms you are willing to play game minutes +/- your age group within the programme - challenge point based.

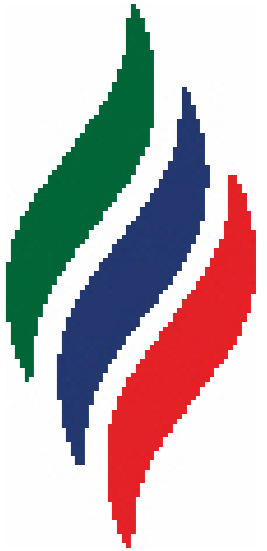

# SEASON TRAINING

Sessions are curriculum based, designed to develop players across the main football moments - Attack - Defense - Transition.

- WEDNESDAY // SET PIECE/VEO/SSG  
 U13 / U14 = 4.30pm - 5.45pm

- THURSDAY // CURRICULUM TRAINING  
 U13 / U14 = 4.30pm - 5.45pm  
 U15 / U17 = 5.45pm - 7.00pm

Squads will train in their age groups - some combined sessions may occur in the event of low numbers.



## VEO

VEO (Video Enhanced Observation) is a video-tagging system that combines video and data to assist learning and development, a mandatory tool within TDP accredited clubs.

Veo is a great learning tool, all players will be provided a personal VEO login at the commencement of the programme.

# CODE OF CONDUCT & MINIMUM EXPECTATIONS

- The training commitment is x3 per week - if you cannot make a session, please inform your coaches by 12.00pm latest on day of training ie. not 5 mins prior to training.
- TDP minimum expectation is 100% attitude, focus and effort - Game Day selections and minutes will be based on all 3 elements.
- It is expected all players and Bay Olympic Club officials participating within the TDP youth environment comply with the [NZF "Code of Conduct"](#) - first and foremost providing a layer of protection for both for our players and the Club.
- Behaviour on and off the pitch - there is no reason to engage with opposition officials and supporters with anything other than positive dialogue.
- Players to show respect for all Bay Olympic players, officials, supporters, and those of the opposition.
- Players to show respect towards referees.
- Bay Olympic players, officials, and supporters - no alcohol or drugs are to be consumed within the TDP training and playing environments, on or off the pitch.

## 2024 TDP FEES

The following fee structure will apply to all players selected for the Bay Olympic 2024 TDP Squad

2024 Season Fee \$225  
 plus Term 1 - \$200 + Term 2 - \$200 + Term 3 - \$200  
**TOTAL ANNUAL PROGRAMME FEE = \$825 (BILLED VIA FRIENDLY MANAGER)**

Season Registration fee must be paid prior to 1st March 2024  
 Term fees will be issued prior to each Term commencement.

## PLAYER FEEDBACK

All TDP coaches have been asked to provide regular player feedback. We encourage players to ask coaches questions should they need clarification of player or team tasks. Individual player feedback will be provided formally at the end of each term.

We will present workshops as an additional learning tool, in previous years, various speakers and topics have been presented.
