



FIFA 2021/22 RULES APPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING AMMENDMENTS

1. Games will start on time. Half time and full time will be signalled by the hooter.
2. Each game will be two x 20 minutes halves, with a 2min half time for the changing of ends.
3. **SHIN PADS ARE COMPULSORY - NO SHINPADS NO PLAY**
4. Goals only count when scored from outside the 'D' (penalty area).
5. The 'D' area is for **GOAL KEEPER** only. No other players can enter.
6. Balls that go out of play ie. corners, throw-ins are to be taken as a ground kick.
7. After handling the ball, goal keepers are only permitted to throw out the ball.
8. A free kick will result if the keeper steps outside of the D.
9. A 6 second rule applies for goal keepers.
10. Back passes picked up result in a penalty, headers are excluded from this rule.
11. Penalty's to be taken from two metres from the edge of the 'D' area.
12. Defenders must be 5metres away from a free kick, and/or at least stand on the semi-circle.
13. Change of goal keepers during the game may only occur at a stoppage of play.
14. Rolling subs are permitted during breaks of play and with notification to the referee. All players need to enter and the leave field with player visible to referee.
15. There is no offside.
16. **FOULS:** Yellow Cards will result in a 3 minute sin bin without player substitution. Red Cards will result in sending off for the rest of the evening (potentially two games in an evening), in addition the player will be stood down for an additional game night. Fouls include offensive language and dissent/harassment offences against the referee or players.
17. Slide tackling (players leaving their feet to complete a tackle) will NOT be permitted. Please make sure all players are aware of this rule. Slide tackling will result in a sin bin or if deemed dangerous by the Referee a Red Card.
18. Any disputes must be put in writing and will be dealt with by the Summer Football Committee, whose decision is final.
